

PRIVACY POLICY

Mosort, LLC (“Mosort”, “Company” or “We”), and its associated brands respect your privacy and are committed to protecting it through our compliance with this Policy.

This Privacy Policy describes how Mosort collects, uses, shares and secures information related to users of our websites (“This Website”), platforms, and applications, including all business services we provide on those digital properties, as well as any services we use to engage or communicate with consumers and to facilitate communications between consumers and the businesses that partner with us. Our primary purpose in collecting and using information about you on our websites is to enable you to effectively use our business services, to provide you with business information responsive to your queries, to facilitate connections between you and businesses with which you engage on This Website, and to provide you with advertisements and marketing that match your interests and preferences.

By visiting Mosort websites, and utilizing services provided across Company websites, or downloading various applications (desktop or mobile), you are acknowledging and accepting our Privacy Policy described in this Privacy Notice and agree to its terms. You also agree to our information practices, including the collection, use, processing, and sharing of your information as described in this Privacy Policy, as well as the transfer and processing of your information to the United States and other countries globally where we have or use facilities, service providers, or partners, regardless of where you use our Services. You acknowledge that the laws, regulations, and standards of the country in which your information is stored or processed may be different from those of your own country.

This Privacy Policy does not apply to the offline activities of Mosort, or any of its affiliates or third parties. It does not apply to any client websites, portal pages, or landing pages we create or host for the benefit of our clients, nor to any third party, including to their collection of any data through any application or content that may link to or be accessed from This Website.

What information do we collect from users visiting our website or using our Services?

We may collect the following kinds of information from and about you:

- Contact information, such as full name, email address and any contact information that you choose to provide when you sign up for our services.
- The information you provide when you use our services.
- The content of all communications on or through the services, user communications, feedback, suggestions and ideas sent to us or any other information that you provide to us when you contact or engage us for support regarding the services.
- Any other information you choose to upload, share with other users or provide to us directly through the services.
- Information about how you use our services, such as the types of content you view or engage with or the frequency and duration of your activities.

- If you use an available feature on This Website to request contact or a quote for providing services or products from any businesses listed or advertised on This Website, we may collect your name and contact information in order to provide it to such businesses or service providers for the purpose of fulfilling your request for information, as per the Terms of Use that govern your use of such features.
- Information Automatically Collected. Mosort collects and may store and share Information that we automatically collect through various technologies when you visit This Website.
- We collect and use the search parameters you enter in connection with a search you conduct through This Website for the purpose of providing you search results responsive to your query and for our internal analysis and other business purposes. We may also collect such search terms if you enter them while conducting a search on a third-party website which links to This Website to provide you the search results.

Mosort may receive information about you from other services you choose to use, such as integrations, according to their terms and policies. We may use information received for the purposes, described in ‘How we use the information we collect’ section of this Policy.

Device information and location

We may collect information from or about the computers, phones or other devices where you install or access our Services, including but not limited to device locations, such as through GPS, Bluetooth, or Wi-Fi signals. We may associate the information we collect from your different devices, to help us provide the Services consistently across your devices.

Log and cookie data

We automatically collect information provided by your browser or operating system through the Services, such as your Internet protocol (IP) address and other browser or device identifiers, browser type, operating system, crash data, pages that you visit before using the Services, the date and time of your visit, information about your activities and actions (the links you follow or pages you view) within the Services and other standard server log information.

Cookie data are small pieces of text used to store information on web browsers. Cookies are used to store and receive identifiers and other information on computers, phones and other devices. Other technologies, including data stored on your web browser or device, identifiers associated with your device and other software, are used for similar purposes. In this Policy, Chanty, Inc. refers to all of these technologies as “cookies”. We use cookies if you have an account (team space) on Chanty. This Policy explains why we use cookies and the choices you have.

Why do we use cookies?

We use cookies to help us provide, protect and improve the Services (which includes the Mosort websites and applications), by personalizing content and providing a safer experience. We may set or log data stored in cookies or local storage objects to automatically collect this information. Your web browser or device offer settings to manage cookie data.

What if you choose to disable cookies in your browser?

Access to some features or Services will be disabled or may function improperly.

Privacy Policy Updates

Our business changes constantly. Our Privacy Policy may change also, and information collected through This Website is subject to the Privacy Policy in effect at the time the information is collected, as noted by the version date at the top of the page.

How does Mosort use, store and share information collected on This Website?

In the course of enabling you to effectively use our business services, providing you with business information responsive to your queries, facilitating connections between you and businesses with which you engage on This Website, and showing you advertisements and marketing that match your interests and preferences, we may use the information we collect from you or about you to respond to your inquiries, administer your account, send you marketing messages, assess your needs and interests in order to better tailor offers and/or display content based upon your interests, allow you to search for information on our site, improve our website and search services, conduct research, and/or list you in our search and directory services. We do this on behalf of ourselves and our client businesses for whom we provide marketing and lead generation services. We also use collected information for the following purposes:

Specific Purpose. When users supply personally identifiable information about themselves for a specific purpose (for example, to register to use a feature on This Website, to inquire about a product or service or business listed or advertised on This Website, to receive information, or to apply for a job), we may use, store, and/or share such information for such purpose, as well as to analyze and improve services provided by Mosort.

Communicating with You. We may also use, store and/or share personally identifiable information you provide or that is automatically collected to communicate with you (e.g., to send you e-mails, text messages or push notifications) and to respond to your requests for information. However, you may request not to receive (i.e., “unsubscribe” from receiving) commercial e-mail messages (the primary purpose of which is the commercial advertisement or promotion of a commercial product or service) from us (either altogether or on a category-by-category basis). If you have opted-in to receive marketing text messages from us, you may also opt-out of receiving such messages going forward by written request.

Protecting Mosort’s Property or Other Rights. In addition, Mosort may use, store and/or share personally identifiable information you provide and information Mosort automatically collects through This Website (and may combine personally identifiable and non-personally identifiable information you provide with information Mosort automatically collects through This Website) as it deems appropriate to protect its property or other rights (for example, to enforce any policies regarding user-provided content, to comply with laws regarding alleged copyright violations, and to prevent fraud).

Improving This Website and Mosort Services. We use, store and/or share information automatically collected through This Website to improve This Website, to monitor its performance, to make This Website easier for you and other users to use, to manage features and programs made available through This Website, and to assess the use of and improve the services Mosort provides or may want to provide.

Does Mosort combine Personally Identifiable Information provided through This Website by users of This Website with offline information about such users?

Mosort reserves the right to combine personally identifiable information you provide through This Website with offline information about you. For instance, if you call a phone number in a business listing or ad on This Website, Mosort may supplement the phone company's Caller-ID information with other information about you when reporting the details of the contact to Mosort's client businesses.

What is Mosort's position regarding online advertising and third-party ad servers?

Mosort may place its own advertisements and/or accept advertisements from third parties that serve advertising on This Website. Mosort may use its own Tracking Methods or Tracking Methods provided by such third parties in the pages containing the ad(s) that Mosort sends to your browser. These Tracking Methods allow Mosort and/or the third parties to automatically collect information (e.g., usage pattern information) about your visit to This Website, and specifically your interaction with this advertising.

Security

How does Mosort secure information?

Mosort is committed to securing and protecting from unauthorized access your Personally Identifiable Information that you provide through This Website. Mosort encrypts any sensitive personal information we may intentionally collect, such as credit card or social security numbers, during transmission and storage. For other types of information, we use reasonable measures to help prevent the information from becoming disclosed to those who are not described in this policy. It is important for you to protect against unauthorized access of any account password or your computer. No security measures are perfect, and we cannot promise that all information collected from you or about you will remain secure in all circumstances.

Customer testimonials and comments

We post customer testimonials and comments on our Websites, which may contain Personal Information. We obtain each customer's consent via email prior to posting the customer's name and testimonial.

Use of credit card information

If you give us credit card information, we use it solely to check your financial qualifications and collect payment from you. We use a third-party service provider to manage credit card processing. This service provider is not permitted to store, retain, or use information you provide except for the sole purpose of credit card processing on our behalf.

How do we secure the information we store?

Mosort has implemented measures designed to secure your personal information from accidental loss, unauthorized access, use, alteration and disclosure. All information you provide to us is stored on secure servers behind firewalls.

Our website is scanned on a regular basis for security holes and known vulnerabilities in order to make your visit to our site as safe as possible. We use system encryption for database files, data transfer encryption and password encryption on the application layer.

Your personal information is contained behind secured networks and is only accessible by a limited number of persons who have special access rights to such systems and are required to keep the information confidential. File system and file storage are encrypted together with isolated storages.

In addition, all sensitive/credit information you supply is encrypted via Secure Socket Layer (SSL) technology. Any billing transactions will be encrypted, processed through a gateway provider and not stored or processed on our servers.

We implement a variety of security measures when a user places an order, enters, submits, or accesses their information to maintain the safety of your personal information.

However, safety and security of your information also depend on you. Where we have given you (or where you have chosen) one-time code or password for access to Mosort Services, you are responsible for keeping the code or password confidential. We ask you not to share your code or password with anyone. We urge you to be careful about giving out information in public areas. The information you share in public areas may be viewed by anyone.

While the transmission of information via the internet and mobile platforms is not completely secure, we do our best to protect your personal information in an environment where we absolute security is not 100% guaranteed. Any transmission of personal information is at your own risk. We are not responsible for circumvention of any privacy settings or security measures we provide.

California Online Privacy Protection Act

California is the first state law in the nation to require commercial websites and online services to post a Privacy Policy (CalOPPA). The law's reach stretches well beyond California to require any person or company in the United States (and conceivably the world) that operates websites collecting Personally Identifiable Information from California consumers to post a conspicuous Privacy Policy on its website stating exactly the information being collected and those

CAN SPAM Act

The CAN-SPAM Act is a law that sets the rules for commercial email, establishes requirements for commercial messages, gives recipients the right to have emails stopped from being sent to them, and spells out tough penalties for violations.

We collect your email address in order to:

- Send information, respond to inquiries, and/or other requests or questions.
- Process orders and to send information and updates pertaining to orders.

To be in accordance with CANSPAM, we agree to the following:

- Not to use false or misleading subjects or email addresses.
- Identify the message as an advertisement in some reasonable way.
- Include the physical address of our business or site headquarters.
- Monitor third-party email marketing services for compliance, if one is used,
- Honor opt-out/unsubscribe requests quickly.
- Allow users to unsubscribe by using the link at the bottom of each email.
